Adult Sunday School

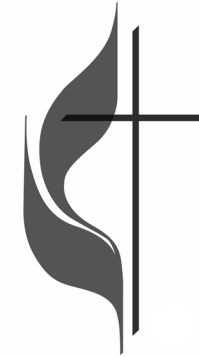
