Brothers and Sisters in Christ this is my last pastor letter to the good people of Emmetsburg First UMC. I want to thank all of you for the MANY ways you have supported myself and my family! I am so grateful you allowed me to be your pastor for two years and the first female pastor here. It is very rare in the UMC that a pastor ever serves their home and sending church, yet I had the privilege and I'm beyond blessed! As the years go by I will always look back fondly on our time together. In the past two years, babies have been born, children have grown up, and people have been hurt or sick. We've had baptisms, confirmations, marriages, and too many funerals. Together we've celebrated, cried, prayed, worshipped, and tried new things. We have learned a lot, our lives have changed, and we have persevered.

As I think about moving I remember Iowa is not that large and I know our paths will cross again. Additionally, because of the ease of technology we can remain friends but I will no longer be your pastor. I love you and social media is great for keeping up with each others lives. I'll rejoice with you as your friend, no longer your pastor, because you'll have a new pastor and that's their role. I know you were a church before I got here and you'll be a church long after I'm gone. I also recognize God has been here since the beginning of this

church and will remain here for all time. If through the power of the Holy Spirit you allow Jesus to be your guide, the Emmetsburg First UMC will always have a mission. It may look different than it did in the past. It may look different than it does right now but a passion for our Lord and Savior will see you through all your future trials. This passion guided the earlier congregations, allowing them to navigate their own trials. They managed and flourished, and so will you when partnered with God.

I pray for a wonderful future for you good people! I've been praying for the new pastor to be appointed, whom at the time of writing this has not been appointed yet. I've been praying they will connect with the community and all of you! I've been praying you will warmly receive them, welcome them into the fold

and into their new leadership position with you.

Lana's Ordination question (last one I'm leaving with you):

How has the practice of ministry informed your understanding of the Nature and Mission of the Church? What are its primary challenges today?

I believe the nature and the mission of the church is to reflect the communal love of God. In my seven years of pastoral ministry, I have been blessed with beautiful examples of the church loving as God loves. When my husband was diagnosed with stage four colon cancer the body of Christ supported us in prayer, hosted a benefit to help financially, and offered unconditional love. When our daughter was diagnosed with Hodgkin's Lymphoma the next year and our son died in a car accident a few days later the body of Christ again gathered around us, holding us in prayer and helping us along the way. As a pastor, I've been blessed to sit with those dying and their families, sharing Christ's love. During a worship service, I was blessed to lead prayer and the laying of hands upon a young family whose father had died three years earlier from a tragic accident and whose mother was actively dying of cancer. On another occasion, we laid hands upon a 15-year-old girl who was facing a major spinal surgery. Each of these, and so many more, are opportunities to love as God loves. To walk alongside one another in the realities of life. As the church, we are to share one another's hardships and rejoice in one another's celebrations. We are family, brothers and sisters in Christ, called-out to love in communal and relational ways.

With this understanding, I believe one of the greatest challenges of the American church is our individualist culture. As I've mentioned several times, God is communal and to be God's image bearer is to live in and for community, the exact opposite of our culture. Another challenge for the church today is the belief that the church is the building rather than the body of Christ. We misunderstand the meaning of church and focus on the building rather than the people. I've heard this struggle consistently as leadership often asks how we can get more people in church, rather than seeing themselves as the church. Another challenge is the role placed upon the church to be the moral character police and the hypocrisy this creates. In many ways the church has become focused on religion and following rules, becoming Pharisees rather than disciples. Too often I've heard people say they need to clean up before coming to church, instead of recognizing we are a hospital for the sick not a museum of saints. I recently had a long conversation with Paul*, who has been deeply hurt from the church. He loves Jesus but the challenges I listed above are issues he and I talked about in depth. These challenges are impacting the church and impacting the way we need to be the church.
