150th Anniversary Fast Fact: The Menu in 1907: If you're interested in what was sometimes served, on March 18, 1907, the Epworth League held their banquet in the Methodist Episcopal Church parlors. The first course was scalloped oysters, creamed potatoes, and hot rolls. The next course was pressed chicken with olives, celery, and sweet pickles. Following that was fruit salad, wafers, and salted almonds. The dessert was maple mousse with angel food, nut or devil's food cake with coffee, punch, and bonbons.
