At the morning service, Ed Scott, Harlan Soper, and Laura Stillman Schroeder (descendants of the early church) filled the box with the following: Bible like the one presented to each child graduating from the Primary Dept of our Sunday School; New Methodist Hymnal; Conference Minutes from our 75th Anniversary; recent Methodist Book of Discipline; New Testament, RSV; two copies of the *Christian Advocate*; names of organists and choir leaders; roll of present church members; Methodist Book of Worship; description of the first church; two copies of current numbers of the Emmetsburg papers; prospectus of the new church; pictures of the church that burned; names of the 27 pastors who had served this charge; names of those who have served as chairmen of Official Board; names of Sunday School teachers; and a silver coin.
