This last week I was reminded that fall is not just a time to harvest—it's also a time to plant. In fact, it's the perfect time for plants to grow deep roots that can withstand

the deep freeze of winter and sweltering heat of summer.

Psalm 1 celebrates the deep roots that form when we live into God's Instruction—which Jesus sums up as Love God by Loving Your Neighbor.

Fall is when we, as a United Methodist Church, harvest AND plant seeds:
